More than 70 percent of inmates return to prison within three years of their release. But thanks to a CFC-supported organization, Jason didn't become a statistic. When he was released from federal prison in March 2015, he came to a nonprofit organization that helped him obtain full-time employment in less than three weeks. Working with a financial counselor, Jason also paid off an old fine to clear his driver's license, and applied to a local university.

Today, Jason is on an Honors scholarship at his university, has been promoted to the freezer department with Associated Foods, and works a part-time security job. He has also improved his credit score from 579 to 671 and has become a clean, contributing member of society.
